



Hard Rock Mine has a Hard Water Problem

THE CHALLENGE

A mining customer was pumping a large quantity of very acidic water from underground and the centrifugal pumps present on site couldn't handle the nature of the water - the pumps needed rebuilding every 4 or 5 days. All Pumps was contacted to come up with a pumping solution that would be suitable for this application, reducing maintenance time and costs.

THE SOLUTION

All Pumps supplied the customer with a Griswold centrifugal CD4, a hardened stainless steel pump mounted on a base plate, with an electric motor.
